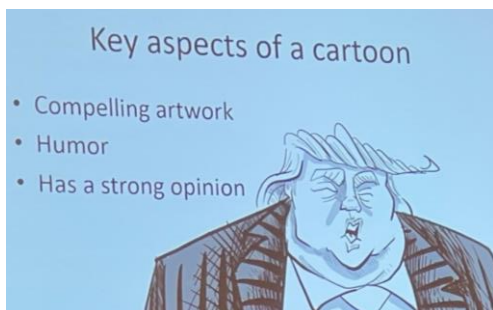
Program: 'Hands on Wisconsin' was presented by Phil Hands, editorial cartoonist for the WI State Journal Madison, Wis. He is the only cartoonist on the staff of a newspaper in Wisconsin. Phil is a fierce political moderate whose cartoons attack the extremists on both the left and the right.

Phil was born in Syracuse, NY and grew up in the Detroit area. He earned a bachelor's degree at Kenyon College in Ohio and a master's at UW-Madison.

His cartoons have appeared in publications like USA Today, Newsweek, Time and The Washington Post. While many of his cartoons tackle national issues, they are generally crafted specifically for his audience in Wisconsin.

Phil has won a number of state awards for editorial cartooning and was the 2012 recipient of the Society of Professional Journalists Sigma Delta Chi award for editorial cartooning for newspapers with circulation under 100,000.
