This station was established in 1988, replacing land that was converted to residential and commercial purposes in Madison. The land area of the station 601 acres while the tillable area is 525 acres. Annually, 70 to 80 projects are conducted.

The missions of the UW-Madison Agricultural Research Stations:

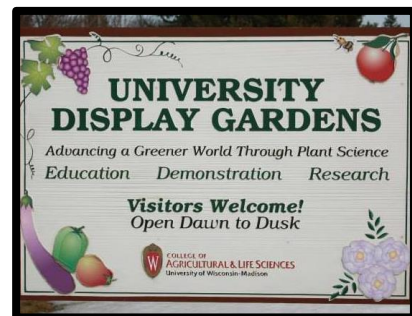
1. Support training of students,
