Program: 'Child Abuse Treatment and Prevention' was presented by Sarah Berndt, Development Director at Canopy Center.

The center serves 500 people annually through their three programs:

1. **Oasis** family sexual abuse treatment program, supports the healthy functioning of families who have been affected by child sexual abuse. Group, individual and family therapy are offered,
2. **CASA of Dane and Columbia Counties** (CASA- Court Appointed Special Advocates), provide an independent voice for children who are under legal protection of the courts due to abuse and neglect,
3. **Parent to Child Supervised Visitation** program provides supervised visits between children and a biological parent who is ordered to or agreed to supervised visits.

Some effects of Trauma:

1. Developmental consequences,
2. Distorted thought and behavior,
3. Overwhelmed and exhaustion,
4. Acting out or instigating conflict and
5. Thrill seeking.
