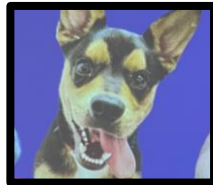
Kiwaniis Club of Madison West – Kiwanogram

Program: 'Dane County Humane Society Partnerships' was presented by Elizabeth Moore, Community Partnership and Coordinator, and Micaela Magel, Humane Educator and Camp Pawprint. Their theme is 'Helping People Help Animals'.

The Society has 29 acres located at the East Side (Verges Road) of Madison and at West side location (Watts Road). They have 100 staff and 1000 volunteers who are expected to volunteer two hours per week and commit to six months.

The society has a major shelter building with adoptable and stray animal housing, adoption center, retail store, animal medical services clinic, humane education facilities, classroom, and administrative offices. They also have a Wildlife Center, Livestock Barn and Felines in Treatment Center
